

What is an MPAN number and how to find it?

A Meter Point Administration Number, also known as MPAN, is an unique number assigned to the electricity supply in your property. It's sometimes also known as your 'Supply Number'.

You can find your MPAN number on your electricity bill. It's a 21-digit number broken down into separate segments like 'Profile Class' and 'Distribution ID'. Here's an example of what it should look like:

| | Profile Type | Meter Time Switch Code | Line Loss Factor |
|----------|---------------------|------------------------|------------------|
| S | 01 | 123 | 456 |
| | 12 | 0123 4567 | 345 |
| | Distributor ID Code | Meter Point ID Number | Check Digit |

The MPAN for the example above is:

01 123 456 12 0123 4567 345.

If you don't have a previous bill, you can find out your MPAN by calling your local electricity supplier.
